- 4. In verse 8, why is Timothy to "remember Christ Jesus, risen from the dead...?"
- 5. What does Paul mean when he states that he is chained, but the word of God is not chained?
- 6. Why is Paul going thru what he is?
- 7. Read 11-13 and explain what you think each of these phrases mean.
