II Timothy 2:1-13

Being strong in the grace

1. How can one "be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus?"
2. Compare II Timothy 2: 1-2 with II Timothy 1:5. Then compare it with Matthew 28:19-20. What is being done in these Timothy scriptures.
3. Paul, with his own death approaching, sees hardship ahead for Timothy and other Christians. In verses 4-6, he uses the three illustrations that help demonstrate characteristics that a dedicated Christian needs. List these illustrations and be prepared to discuss what they mean to us.
4. In verse 8, why is Timothy to "remember Christ Jesus, risen from the dead...?"
5. What does Paul mean when he states that he is chained, but the word of God is not chained?
6. Why is Paul going thru what he is?
7. Read 11-13 and explain what you think each of these phrases mean.
