2. Why is it important for a worker "not to be ashamed" of his work? What does it mean to rightly divide the truth (#G3718 in Strong's Greek Lexicon which literally means "cut in a straight line" or "dissect correctly")?
3. Who was Hymenaeus? Why is the term cancer used to describe this situation?
4. Read verses 19-21 and explain in your own words what these verses mean and be prepared to discuss. How does one become vessel of honor?
5. What are the characteristics of a servant of the Lord in verse 24-25?
6. If we have been taken captive by the devil, how do we escape?
