1 Corinthians Lesson 23 Weds 7/25/2018



In our last lesson we considered the topic of spiritual gifts. Now we will get back into the flow of the text.

- In vs 4-6, Paul notes 3 areas of differences between Christians. <u>List each</u> of the 3 areas, & what each one <u>means</u>. (It may help you to look at different translations.)
- **2. A.** Despite these *differences*, what is *the same* about them? (vs 4-6, 11)
 - **B.** What is the *purpose* for these differences? (vs 7, vs 3)
- **3.** Paul uses the human body as an example we can easily understand, to illustrate his points about Christ's spiritual body (the church). Explain his human body illustration what are his **physical** points in:
 - **A.** Vs 15-16
 - **B.** Vs 17-19
 - **C.** Vs 20-22
 - **D.** Vs 23-24
- 4. What is the spiritual parallel Paul makes in vs 27-30?
- **5.** Paul makes the same point in a condensed format in Rom 12:3-8, & similarly in Eph 4:1-7 & :11-16. What *difference* do you see in the gifts listed in *those* passages, from 1 Cor 12:8-10?
- **6.** There are not miraculous spiritual gifts today, but these principles still apply. **How do we put them in use in the church today?** [consider your answers to each section of question 3]; [also look at 1 Cor 12:25-26, :12-14]; [also consider Eph 4:1-7 & :11-16, Rom 12:3-8]
- **7.** From the passages we've looked at, why do some people have different or stronger spiritual abilities than me? Is this a good thing or a bad thing?
