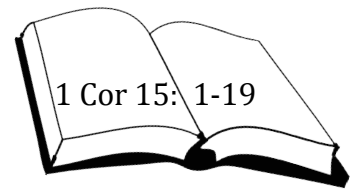


**The Reality of Christ's

1 Corinthians

1. In 15:1, *what* does Paul say he is about to tell them – what does he call it / how does he describe it?
2. From 15:3-4, what IS this message that he is again telling them?
3. How does this fit with Heb 6:1-2?
4. Most people today think that Jesus' being raised from the dead is "Christian legend", that it didn't really happen. **How do YOU know He really DID rise from the dead?** (see 15:5-8; Lk 24:34; Lk 24:36-43 & Jn 20:19-23; Mt 28:10 & 16; Jn 7:5 with Mk 3:20-21 with Gal 1:18-19; Jn 20:24-29)
5. Why do you think that people (both people in the world, and even those of us in the church) have so much trouble comprehending a "resurrection of the dead" – why do we have trouble really envisioning that and really believing in that?
6. Paul lists several things that would have to be true, if there is no resurrection. What does he point out? **If there is no resurrection of the dead, then:**
